If SWICA Healthcare Insurance Ltd or SWICA Insurances Ltd is not the risk bearer, the insurance applications and the data they contain may be shared with the third-party insurers that have entered into a sales partnership with SWICA Healthcare Insurance Ltd or SWICA Insurances Ltd (such as European Travel Insurance, Coop Rechtsschutz AG or Simpego Versicherungen AG).
